THIS IS A SPORTER AIR RIFLE LEAGUE. THE NATIONAL STANDARD THREE-POSITION RULES WILL GOVERN SHOOTING.

AIR RIFLE WILL SHOOT AT 33 FT. ON AR 5-10 TARGET or AR/5-1 .

TEAM SCORES WILL BE ON A WON LOST RECORD. INDIVIDUAL WILL BE ON A TOTAL AGGREGATE FOR THE SEASON.

JUNIORS MUST STILL BE IN SCHOOL (K1 THRU 12) and age 20 or under and live in Iowa.

EQUIPMENT: TO MEET NATIONAL STANDARD 3-POSITION RULES FOR SPORTER AIR RIFLE.

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 FOR INDIVIDUAL, NO CHARGE FOR TEAM. TEAM SCORES WILL BE TAKEN FROM INDIVIDUAL SCORES. TOP FOUR SHOOTERS FROM EACH CLUB WILL REPRESENT CLUB AS A TEAM. SHOULD A CLUB DESIRE TO HAVE MORE THAN ONE TEAM, THEY SHALL DESIGNATE THE SHOOTERS TO REPRESENT EACH TEAM ie A CLUB HAS 12 SHOOTERS; THEY MAY DECIDE TO HAVE TWO TEAMS WITH SIX SHOOTERS REPRESENTING EACH TEAM (HIGH FOUR) OR THEY MAY ELECT TO HAVE THREE TEAMS OF FOUR SHOOTERS EACH. ONCE THE TEAMS ARE SET UP THEY CANNOT BE CHANGED.

COURSE OF FIRE: 10 SHOTS PRONE, 10 SHOTS STANDING, AND 10 SHOTS KNEELING.

CATEGORIES: AGE IN THE YEAR 2010- JUNIOR: 17,18,19, AND 20, INTERMEDIATE JUNIOR: 15, AND 16, SUB JUNIOR: 14 AND UNDER

AWARDS: MEDALS-1ST, 2ND, 3RD, TROPHY TO TEAM CHAMPION. AWARDS MAY BE INCREASED DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF SHOOTERS.
