Location: West Liberty, Ia – proceed thru business district to Depot Park, turn left and over the tracks on Prairie St., to edge of town, range will be on the right.

Competitors: Must be IOWA STATE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION members, or members of their home association . Juniors must be members of home State Rifle and Pistol Association affiliated or club.

Classification: NRA classification system will be used. Classes will be combined upward to achieve 5 in class. All adults will shoot in Precision Air Rifle division. Unclassified shooters will shoot in the master class. Juniors will shoot in Junior, Intermediate Junior, and Sub-Junior categories.

Air Rifle: NRA rules for Precision Air Rifle will govern Precision Air Rifle.  
NRA rules for Sporter Air Rifle will govern Sporter Air Rifle.

Target: AR-5/10 at 33 feet.

Course of Fire: 3 X 20      Match #1 20 shots prone      Match #3 20 shots kneeling  
   Match #2 20 shots standing      Match #4 Aggregate

Relays: Relay #1 – 8:30 AM      Relay #2 – 11:00 AM (limit of 15 shooters per relay)

Entry Fee: Adults - \$20.00 Juniors - \$10.00 Includes registration fees. (NRA\$5.50, state\$3.00)  
Team match - \$5.00 per team(team match will not be a fired match, scores will be taken from match #4) 4 persons on a team, team members to be determined before shooters start match #1

Challenge fee: \$1.00

Awards: Awards will be cash to adults and ribbons to juniors in match 4(aggregate only). Win - \$25.00, 1<sup>st</sup> in class - \$15.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> in class - \$10.00, if over 10 in class. Ribbons to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each category for juniors. Iowa resident Champion will have his or her name on traveling trophy plus plaque to the resident high adult and high junior to be presented at the Iowa State Rifle and Pistol banquet.. Team awards will be ribbons to each shooter on a team for first, second, and third place teams. Separate awards in Sporter Air Rifles will be, plaque to resident champion and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons each categories

Conditions: Competitors will hang and retrieve targets, sponsors will score. Competitors will furnish their own eye protection.

Facilities: 15 firing points, pop and coffee available. Indoor restrooms.
