POLICY: Iowa State Championship Application and Approval Process

1. The applying sponsor club must submit a proposed match program to the proper ISRPA Committee Chairman a minimum of four months prior to the match.
2. The eligibility statement of the match program must read as follows: "Open to all competitors. Iowa residents must be members of the Iowa State Rifle and Pistol Association. Be prepared to show membership cards. Applications for the Iowa state rifle and pistol association will be available."
3. The award statement of the match program must include the following: "competitors will only receive one state association award per state match."
4. The appropriate Committee Chairman will review the proposal and either return the program to the applicant for correction and re-evaluation or forward to the National Rifle Association for final approval.
5. Upon receipt of approval from the National Rifle Association, sponsoring club will provide copies of approved program to Iowa State Rifle and Pistol Association secretary.
6. No additional changes to the program will be allowed after it has been approved by the appropriate Committee Chairman and the National Rifle Association without the approval of both. No other matches will be fired simultaneously with a State Championship Match with the exception of a CMP-sanctioned Excellence in Competition match unless approved in advance by the ISRPA Committee Chair and the National Rifle Association.
7. Official match results must be completed and sent to the ISRPA Committee Chairman within 14 days of the completion of the match, using the official form and envelope provided.
8. All official rules and general regulations for sanctioned tournament in the NRA rulebooks must be followed.

This policy was approved this 24 day of October, in the year 2009 by the Board of Directors of the Iowa State Rifle and Pistol Association.
