POLICY: Firearm Loan Program

One mission of the Iowa State Rifle and Pistol Association (ISR&PA) is to promote the competitive shooting sports among clubs and members in Iowa. To accomplish this, the Association maintains a stock of firearms to loan to members of the association.

I. Guidelines for Issuing Firearms

A. Who Qualifies?

1. Any person who is a current member in good standing of the NRA and ISR&PA. A member will be considered a junior competitor until 31 December of the calendar year in which his/her twentieth (20th) birthday occurs. All other members are designated as Adult members. Members need not be members of a shooting club (but must be members of the ISR&PA) to be considered for loan of a firearm. A loan of a firearm to a person under the age of 18 (21 for handguns), must be approved and signed for by that members parent or legal guardian.

B. Priority of Issue:

1. New Junior members (with parent or legal guardian approval)
2. Junior members (with parent or legal guardian approval)
3. New Adult members
4. Adult members

C. Specifics of issue:

1. Members will be issued one firearm for one shooting season.
2. The member must agree to provide proof (match bulletin, letter from match director, ect.) that he/she fired the firearm in at least one NRA approved or registered competition, or a CMP Excellence-in-Competition (Leg) Match. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of deposit.

D. Responsibility and Liability


1. The member to whom the firearm has been issued is responsible for safe-keeping and maintaining the firearm in its condition at time of issue.
2. In the event of theft or loss, the member will be assessed full replacement value for replacement. Legal action will be initiated, if necessary, to recover full replacement value plus legal expenses. Deposit is forfeit and will NOT be applied to replacement cost.
3. In the event of damage, the member will be responsible for all costs associated with returning the firearm to as-issued condition. Deposit may be applied to repair costs, unless damage is intentional.
4. Firearms will be returned to the Equipment Custodian no later than December 1st of every year, or deposit is forfeit, and firearm will be considered stolen.

II. Procedures for Requesting Issue.



- A. Application requests can be found at www.iowastateriflepistol.org. Applications received during the month of December in any year will be disregarded. Applications will be processed in a first come, first served process following the priority of issue in Para 1, Section B
- B. The member requesting issue will, upon being contacted, be responsible for pick-up and return of the firearm.
- C. A fee of \$120 will be paid to the ISRPA General Fund for every year of use by member. Of this fee, \$40 will be retained by the association to help pay for routine maintenance, and \$80 is considered to be a deposit that will be returned to the member upon return of the firearm, except as listed in Para II, Section D.
- D. The \$80 deposit will be refunded by the Association Treasurer upon return of the firearm to the Equipment Custodian in as-issued condition, less normal wear and tear, except in the following instances:
 1. Member fails to prove that he/she fired in an NRA approved or registered competition, or a CMP Leg Match. Per Para I, Section C(2)
 2. Equipment is not returned on or before December 1 of the year it was issued, unless special arrangements have been made with the ISRPA Equipment Custodian in advance. Per Para I, Section D(4)
 3. The firearm is damaged, other than through normal wear and tear. Per Para I, Section D(4)
 4. The firearm is lost or stolen. Per Para I, Section D(2)
