Motion by Besgrove to buy a 1-year junior membership in the NRA for any junior who joins the ISR&PA. 2<sup>nd</sup> Craig Swartz. Approved.

Besgrove reported the last newsletter went out to those receiving e-mail. Worked well and we are receiving job well done from some of the members.
