Motion by Ray Dietrich to give \$250 for teams going to National Junior Air Rifle Championship (Bloomington, IL in July). 2nd Bill Mullan. Ray amended motion for \$300. Bill Mullan seconded the amendment. The amendment was approved and then the motion was approved.
