Old Business:

Besgrove received a letter from Cadet 1st Lt. Jaymie Van Zandt thanking the State Assoc. for our support sending a team to the National Junior Air Rifle Championship at Bloomington, IL.

Bert Izzard submitted descriptions and prices on a card laminator. Motion by Bill Besgrove to purchase model 5000 ID solutions machine and 500 pack of lamination cards. 2nd Ray Dietrich. Approved.

Bill Besgrove reported Jesse Jans of KUHLE, PHILLIPS, & JANS, INC. recommended becoming a 501 (c) (3) organization. Motion by Ray Dietrich to have CPA Jans set the Assoc. up as 501 (c) (3). 2nd Paul Porter. Approved.

Bert Izzard submitted estimates on new State Assoc. decals. Motion by Bill Besgrove to purchase 1000 State Assoc. decals from *Signs and Designs* for \$533.00 and a one-time die-cutter charge of \$128.00. 2nd Ray Dietrich. Approved.

New Business:

Paul Porter gave a pistol report. State Outdoor Pistol held at West Liberty Gun Club. 25 competitors fired the match with 9 out of state competitors. There weren't enough competitors interested in shooting The Iowa Leg Match. Paul believes cost may be part of the problem and not very many competitors want to use factory hardball ammo in their guns. Next year the program will be changed to allow *any safe ammo*.

Motion to table doing anything about the DNR Iowa Range Proposal until Bill Mullan can be present. 2nd Ray Dietrich.

Besgrove asked if we should explore working with *The Iowa Sportsman* magazine. Will ask for a copy of magazine.

Motion By Bill Besgrove to purchase 12 t-shirts, each in S, M, L for junior use at the Nationals and 24 Polo Shirts in L, XL with Iowa State Rifle & Pistol Assoc. logo on the back. 2nd Paul Porter. Approved.

Motion to adjourn by Ray Dietrich, 2nd Paul Porter. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 1:50 pm.
