RSO CLASS:

The goal of the NRA Range Safety Officer (RSO) Training Program is to develop NRA Certified Range Safety Officers who possess the KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, and ATTITUDES essential to organizing, conducting, and supervising SAFE shooting activities and range operations.

What are RSO's? What do they do? Are they really necessary? Range Safety Officers are individuals who have received training from an NRA Training Counselor. The training teaches the RSO how to inspect a range for safe shooting, how to make sure that all shots fired will stay within the range. He is also taught how to react in the event of an emergency, more importantly, how to reduce the possibility of an emergency occurring in the first place. They are also taught how to assist a shooter that has a problem while shooting, such as a mis-fire or jam. Taught how to set up a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) book for the range, which details the types of matches, the equipment needed, and the procedures to be followed for each type of match.

Are they really necessary? I can answer that with a **YES**. Why? In today's political and legal atmosphere, it may become necessary for each club, private range operator, and public range operator to protect themselves by having at least one such trained person on site.

I can speak of one POLICE range that had no trained RSO on duty one day when a single individual officer was practicing, and decided to move forward to shoot a shorter distance instead of moving the target back closer to the firing line. The bullets from this officer's gun went OVER THE TOP of the backstop, hitting and penetrating residences about a mile away.

Needless to say, this particular range has been shut down permanently, and the officer has been disciplined.

Dave Head will conduct an RSO class on Sat. Oct. 11, 2003 at the Colony Village Restaurant at the Junction of Hwy 151 and Interstate 80 (exit 225). The class would start at 8:00am and finish by 4 or 5 PM. The cost of a "student package" for NRA Range Safety Officer Training is \$25.00. ISR&PA RIFLE LOAN PROGRAM:

The State Assoc. has many highpower and smallbore rifles available to clubs, juniors and members of the Assoc. These rifles are maintained in competition ready condition. When I began shooting highpower rifle in the early 90's I borrowed a M-14 from the Assoc. They are all good shooting rifles. I even made the Presidents 100 at Perry in 1993 with that M-14. There are 3 AR-15's available for junior use, along with some M-1 Garand rifles. For smallbore shooters we have 4 Mod. 12 H&R rifles.

Any one wishing to check out one of these rifles would have to pay \$40 a year for their use. This money helps provide any needed repairs to the rifles. A small price to pay for a competition ready rifle. Rifles can be checked out and arraignments for pick up made through Robert Mead at 319-266-6223.

IOWA RANGES:

The Poweshiek County Sportsman's Association was started in 1982 mostly as a shooting club with early DCM affiliation to help with shooting supplies. It has evolved into trap, pistol, smallbore, highpower and archery. Today we are still CMP affiliated and members of the Iowa State Association. Annual dues are \$25 for the whole family.

In 1990 we purchased 5 acres of land 1 ½ mile south of Montezuma, Iowa to establish what we feel is the best 100 yard rifle range in Iowa. There are 20 firing points that are very well shaded for those hot summer days. From March to September we hold monthly NRA approved high power and smallbore prone matches.

The club also has an indoor 50-foot range for smallbore and pistol, a trap range and 3-D archery range on land 3 miles west and ½ mile south of Montezuma. This land is owned by the County Conservation which we have had a very good working relationship with. We hold 3-D archery matches during the summer open to the public where there are more than 200 shooters at each contest.

As far as the NRA matches go we had 5 on the team. Paul Porter (Captain), Bruce Woodford (Coach), Brian Mallette, Tom Hunt, and Joe Jindrich. We did not fare all that well with the 22. There were gun problems, so we ended up 11 out of 11. CF problems continued and we finished 9/11. 45 went about the same way but the finish was a little better 6/10. Overall aggregate reflected the problems we were having with a 10 out of 12 showing. It was not a good year.
